Instructions:

46 BIRD HOUSES

Pattern #427 in the One Nighter Series from Jeanette Crews Designs.

Use 2 strands of floss for the full crosses and 1 strand for the backstitch, unless otherwise noted in the color key.

Backstitch

000 / 2 - Use 1 strand of White for the beak on 5.

310 / 403 - Use 2 strands of Black for the words on 13 and 25.

310 / 403 - Use 1 strand of Black for all else.

729 / 890 - Use 1 strand of Old Gold, med. for the beak on 30 and 44.

321 / 3046 - Use 1 strand of Christmas Red for the words on 11 and 34.

814 / 45 - Use 1 strand of Garnet, dk. for all on 23 except bird and hearts.

931 / 1034 - Use 1 strand of Antique Blue, med. for ornamentation on 20, and cat collar on 45.

3345 / 268 - Use 1 strand of Hunter Green, dk. for all stems, grass, and shamrocks on 13.

French Knots

726 / 295 - Use 2 strands of Topaz, lt. for eye on 43.

310 / 403 - Use 2 strands of Black for all other eyes.
